We are delighted to invite you to the **98th Pakistan Learning Festival (PLF)** Lahore, to be held at the prestigious Civil Services Academy, Walton Campus, Lahore, on 21st and 22nd April 2026. This year’s theme is **“Learning for Peace and Sustainability”**

The PLF, hosted by Idara-e-Taleem-o-Aagahi (ITA) and co-hosted by the Civil Services Academy, Walton Campus, is Pakistan’s largest interactive learning festival, bringing together children, teachers, families, and communities for a unique learning experience.

PLF is inclusive and open to all students as a free event, from every school system, welcoming students with disabilities. The festival celebrates creativity, critical thinking, joy of reading, and collaboration. We invite students/teachers and schools to explore how learning can inspire positive change for peace and our planet. Students are encouraged to showcase their original work in art, models and writing that reflects innovation, responsibility, and creativity to address challenges.

Examples of how students can participate include:

Peace and Climate Action & STEM Projects: Models, experiments, or solutions that demonstrate tolerance, sustainable practices, renewable energy, conservation, or ways to mitigate climate change.

Creative Expression for Peace and Sustainability: Theatre performances, poetry, storytelling, and creative writing that explore themes of harmony, resilience, and environmental stewardship.



The models will be displayed and all displays will be given e-certificates. There will be a two day open mic area (bol kay lab azad hein teray), which will host students' theatre, debates, poetry and prose.

Digital & Physical Presentations: Projects, videos, or interactive exhibits that highlight actions by individuals or communities to promote sustainability, peace, and responsibility.

Through these activities, students not only develop knowledge and skills but also become agents of change, reflecting the spirit of learning for a sustainable and peaceful future. All participating students presenting their models, projects, or creative pieces will receive PLF participation certificates.

Highlights of PLF Lahore 2026:

- Interactive sessions with authors, poets, storytellers, climate and STEM experts, artists, musicians, and educators
- Workshops on creative writing, STEM, AI, coding, understanding Sufi poetry performing arts, climate awareness, heritage education, and digital skills
- Open Mic Sessions: "Bol Ke Lab Azaad Hain", for students to share reflections, models, posters, or performances
- Opportunities to learn beyond textbooks for curiosity, expression, and innovation
- Showcasing school-led peace initiatives and pledges, climate action initiatives with colorful banners and digital displays

Practical Guidelines for Schools & Participants:

- Schools may send as many students as feasible each day (9:00 am – 4:00 pm), accompanied by teachers and student leaders.
- Transportation is the responsibility of the school; parking is available on-site.
- Students may bring packed lunches; however, food and drink stalls will be available at reasonable rates.
- Teachers are requested to accompany students to sessions, ensure familiarity with session locations, learn to replicate and maintain discipline during sessions.
- Open Mic presentations are limited to 3 minutes per student and 8 minutes per school; all work must be student-created and original.

Schools may choose to bring their colorful cloth/paper banners measuring 2 feet by 5 feet, which will be displayed during the event on the theme
