Young Author Award (YAA) is an initiative of Pakistan Learning Festival, a flagship program of Idara-e-Taleem-o-Aagahi to promote young Pakistani writers (10-18) who demonstrate extraordinary passion and talent for authentic writing.

#### Why you should apply?

If you have a passion for writing authentically with original ideas then this opportunity is for you to shine. Winners will not only receive cash prizes, medals, recognition certificates but also receive a comprehensive 3 months of mentorship from renowned Authors to polish their writing skills and a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to get their stories published from the PLF platform.

Winners will be provided with extensive growth opportunities to represent their stories in various events organized by PLF.

#### Who Can Participate:

- All children who are 10-18 years old and based in Pakistan can participate.
- Stories can be submitted both in Urdu and English
- The stories should be original, unpublished and must be written by the child
- · The winners of previous Young Author Award batches are not eligible to apply again for 5 years after their winning submission.
- Age Group: 10-13 years and 14-18 years

### WINNERS WILL RECEIVE **CASH PRIZES &** 3 MONTHS MENTOR SHIP



Provincial Level Recognition Award and Certificates for Shortlisted Stories will also be given.

The two categories are divided by the following age group and language:

**URDU** 

Category I Urdu

(age 10-13) 1500 to 2000 words

Category 2 Urdu

(age 14-18) 2800 to 3300 words

**ENGLISH** 

Category I English

(age 10 13) 1500-2000 words

Category 2 English

(age 14-18) 2800-3300 words

- Stage I Submission
- Stage II Jury Selection
- Stage III Decision of the YAA
- Stage IV Mentorship Program for YAA
  3 months with eminent Authors to
  improve their narratives

Mentorship is online -rarely face to face

This is compulsory and all YAA who are not able to comply can be dropped from the YAA program

- Stage V Refining their stories/submissions
- Stage VI The Award is Finalized and Awarded publicly
- Stage VII ITA/PLF seeks to finalize the publication for printing
